B a c k g r o u n d	<p>Public concerns on state of Allotments, glass, tyres, fly tipping.</p> <p>Broken wooden rail by gate.</p> <p>Fencing to field on the right of site.</p> <p>Fly tipping bark.</p> <p>Security on site.</p>
C o n s i d e r a t i o n s	<p>18<sup>th</sup> January 2022, Myself, Keenan and Simon Emeny walked around the site.</p> <p>There is no glass to be found and no fly tipping. Yes, a couple of tyres on one plot, but nothing can be done until end of their tenancy.</p> <p>The broken rail by the gate needs to be reattached.</p> <p>The chicken wire fence to the right of the allotments is on the ground, this fence is past our boundary and doesn't belong to the council, it is the farmers responsibility. We do not have any fencing on that side of the site.</p> <p>Public complaint about fly tipping of bark, this is not fly tipped, the tenants are using it for paths on their plots and to lay down on the track between the new 14 plots and the older plots, so they are able to drive to their plots without getting stuck in the mud on the field.</p> <p>The allotments have been broken into again and one tenant has had some equipment taken.</p>
P r o p o s a l s	<p>a) Will arrange for broken rail to be nailed back on at no cost to the PC.</p> <p>b) To contact farmer to repair fencing.</p> <p>c) Identified 3 allocated places on site for the deliveries of bark (2 x left of entrance to site 1 x back left of site map provided).</p> <p>d) To invest in 6 LED security motion sensor solar lights to place around the site to help with security problems.
