The Orchards 1<sup>st</sup> June Agenda Item 14 Update

Enforcement site visit 2/8/21, very concerned over the trees with TPO's cut to short trunks. Unable at that time to gain access to the site itself to consider the pigeon loft that looks like an annex.

27<sup>th</sup> September – The Pigeon Loft is not being used as accommodation and has been clad in brick effect rather than brick itself, therefore no beach of planning control.

Trees with TPO's – investigation on going. Chased as no further update as of 22<sup>nd</sup> November. Remains outstanding January 2022

Enforcement 3<sup>rd</sup> September

A member of the public raised concerns over the number of caravans sited down Charlton Lane at Torton Paddock. W/15/01391/PN was approved for 1 x residential static caravan and 1 x touring caravan only, more caravans on site than approved and has been taken up with enforcement. Chased as no further update as of 22<sup>nd</sup> November. Remains outstanding January 2022

Damaged Planter

Following an accident by Charlton Lane around 8pm 15<sup>th</sup> September the insurance company has now given the go ahead to repair the planter and reposition the sign. 20<sup>th</sup> January 2022 the Contractor informed to make good the repairs. 10<sup>th</sup> Jan 2022 W C Cllr emailed to see if the 30MPH warning sign on the B4193 could be moved towards Stourport to give more of a warning to motorists in the hope another accident may be prevented.

Funeral at St James Church

Numerous emails from a member of the public to a P Cllr about roads being blocked for a second time due to funerals. Parish Council has limited powers to act. Will discuss with the police and church.

Complaint Heras Fencing at Village Hall

Met with the OD Society Saturday morning to address their concerns.

Mitre Oak Tree

Contacted by a member of the parish about the historic tree. Waresley House Mansion residents offered to donate £100 to help defray any costs for its preservation. Suggestion to plant bright climbing roses. Tree warden asked for their advice. Look to tidy up the area and place a plaque.
