Title	Parking on Quarry Bank
B a c k g r o u n d	<p>I was contact by a member of the public about the parking on Quarry Bank. It is causing issues to both residents and road users. The particularly bad point is where the road goes between the rocks as this section is narrow and obscures the view of people trying the exit their drive. It is especially bad for the people who live up the small track to the Old Grammar School.</p> <p>When travelling uphill if cars are parked you are travelling blindly on the brow of a hill on the wrong side of the road.</p>
C o n s i d e r a t i o n s	<p>What can be done to alleviate this?</p> <p>Parking is needed for the church and the houses on quarry bank who don't have a driveway so a small section of double yellow lines by the rocks should not cause too much inconvenience but help solve the problem</p>
P r o p o s a l	<p>Double yellow lines on the right hand side (as you come down the hill) for the section between the rocks to the start of the track up to the Old Grammar School. This would leave a clear view up the hill and stop the need to travel up a blind hill on the wrong side of the road</p>
