



CLERKS REPORT. **HPC Meeting Tuesday 1st June 2021**

28th April Under 11's wishing to use the facilities at the parish hall no reply from 4th April therefore passed to the PHMC Communication Team.

28th April, following the FC meeting Tuesday 27th, an ex-parish councillor who attended the meeting emailed the Clerk, they have the Councils Smart water Kits from 2018.

29th April for the PHMC Communications Team help, Hall hire, Patio Doors, Financials/Assets, PHMC meeting.

10th May. Concerns- why the concrete blocks had not been removed after the pot holes had been repaired as they remained on the car park. Previously discussed and agreed by Cllrs Ingham and Buck and the Chair and Vice Chair of the PHMC, to leave the concrete blocks until full repair undertaken and not just the potholes.

10th May. Concern -that the one concrete block by the fencing did not allow people parked in the lower car park to walk to the village hall without walking on the planting. This has been addressed and a gap made of 4ft .

10th May. Concern -why the removal of the concrete barriers had been undertaken by a vehicle heavier than an HGV. To confirm the vehicle used was not heavier than an HGV, it's weight was only 4.3 tonnes which is lighter than a HGV which would weigh 7.5 tonnes.

11th May. Speeding, Waresley road, this concern has been outstanding since Nov 2020. A proper speed monitoring plan will be addressed by Worcestershire County Council.

11th May, from our District Councillor Stephen Bateman, SWDP Traveller Briefing, there are no new sites planned for Hartlebury.

11th May from our District Councillor Stephen Bateman, details still to follow with regards £10K funding I from the sale of the Old British Legion site.

11th May. District Councillor Stephen Bateman, will look for the Community Project funding proposal.
