

CLERKS REPORT.

HPC Meeting Wednesday 5th May 2021. Agenda Item 17

2nd FOI request received, Clerk replied 1st April 2021.

Email to District Councillor 23rd March asking for his DC report to include the following, outstanding speeding concern 10th November 2020, £10,000 funding from the sale of the Old British legion outstanding from 13th Nov. £250 promised funding for the website not received. Another reminder 8th April 2021.

Planning Enforcement, if not possible to remove the loose brickwork from the terrace/patio area so the Heras Fencing can be positioned closer to the building then as a temporary solution and with directional signage it can be agreed the use of both entrances as both in/outs. The PC would be responsible for any risk assessments and management of these arrangements.

The current situation has not changed in regard to virtual meetings ending 6th May 2021, however parties have lobbied the Government and the date of the hearing 19th April. Judgement expected by the end of that month. Until such time all Parish Councils must meet face to face after 6th May 2021

The fish/chip mobile van visits have been postponed (Tuesday meeting on the village green) they won't resume until their licence has been extended to cover all the Parishes within the WDC area.

13/4, Reported – gypsies had moved onto the allotment field to the right, dogs in kennels, put up picket fences, cut away fences and allowed dogs to foul. Cllr Atkinson called to help. No problem new allotment tenants moving onto the new plots on the left of the field.

A member of the public would like it be known if any spare ground, they would like to rent for their pony.
