Title	Community Legacy Grant Scheme	
B a c k g r o u n d	<p>The scheme must be a large ambitious capital project that has a positive lasting impact on the community.</p> <p>Grant funding £10,000 to £150,000 plus match funding also a requirement.</p> <p>Opening date for Expressions of Interest 4th January 2022, closing date 4th March 2022. Template to be sent shortly.</p> <p>Only Parish and Town Councils may apply with up to two priorities.</p>	
C o n s i d e r a t i o n s	<p>The Parish Council to consider the following :-</p> <p>To secure the future of the Hartlebury Allotment Ground by making an offer to buy said ground.</p> <p>To increase the opportunities of usage by raising some allotment beds with sleepers to encourage the disabled user.</p> <p>To allow the local parish schools to use a section of the ground for educational needs.</p> <p>The project to include a large sustainable timber structure.</p> <p>The structure to become a community hub for “how to grow” and other environmental lessons/training, with the possibility to sell the allotment produce as a further consideration.</p> <p>The timber structure to be “off grid” but would have the installation of solar panels for electricity and a ground source heat pump for warmth.</p> <p>Security of the site would more than likely also be required plus a more substantial track for all to use.</p>
