Matters arising - discussion of how to respond to parishioners pointing out breaches of planning.

1. Parish Website planning page was discussed, (Andrew has done an excellent job), and updated it with an introduction. Andrew has also updated the weekly lists. The links to the individual plans is very effective.

2. Planning applications still outstanding were discussed and the recommendations are -

02206 Outline planning -new dwelling at Milldridge Farm for Farm manager-No objections

02267 Barn3 Norchard Farm extension -No objections

01689 Outline planning -8 Self builds off Summerfield Lane-noted that the site will change the character of the area, is within the blast zone, will increase the traffic volumes and may stress the utilities provision. Provided that these issues are resolved - No objections

02378 Roxel -No objections

3. Response to Tyler Hill communication. Their response simply restates their position without addressing any of our concerns. It was agreed that we should respond with a letter via the Clerk rejecting their position as ignoring it may be used to imply agreement and acceptance. The proposed development may be beneficial to the power supply and Tyler-Hill but not to the 'area' . Ed and Clare S to agree format.
