The original access track was repaired in 2021 and remains in reasonable repair. The first 100m of track has been patched up by the allotment tenants using the leftover material from the councils repairs in 2021. As this use of track has increased it is now degrading slightly. The newer plots (26-55) have no reinforcement for vehicle access to their plots, so in wet weather cars are getting stuck in the mud. | |

The solution to this problem would be to install a grass reinforcement track around the most vulnerable parts of the site.
