It is with some disappointment that we were unable to submit a request for grant funding for a VAS sign on the A4025 it was an ideal opportunity. Unfortunately there has been no indication that a traffic survey has been carried out and approval given by the Highways Dept. WCC.

We will continue to press TM for the surveys on Stourport Road, Old Worcester Road, and Waresley Road/Quarry Bank.

We have received a letter from a parishioner regarding the issues on Inn Lane. This will be an ongoing situation that requires the input from Highways Dept and maybe traffic surveys, it has been a problem within the parish for some time and will require more views form parishioners. Perhaps we need to carry out canvassing on those people directly affected.

Community Speed Policing: We will request volunteers at Community Conversation in February from all residents. Ben Mawby PCSO was contacted but unable to supply any additional info on Smart Water or the use of marker pens for CC2.

We have submitted a list of roads to the police and Councillor Miller that require initial speed camera monitoring: A4025, Waresley Road/Quarry Bank and Old Worcester Road towards Kidderminster after Station Road junction. Be advised that these will have increased police attention.

CCTV: John Cosham was invited to attend a presentation by Vale Fire and Security on the proposed installation of CCTV by the Parish Hall as we need to link our CCTV coverage of the MUGA and carparks with the power from the hall. We will now produce 3 quotations to submit to the Council. John Cosham invited Andrew Scheps and Chris Neale to also attend as independent citizens as their expertise in understanding the system was required. All communications on this matter will be through Cllr Pratt who is the council's representative on HPHMC.

Fly tipping: Cllr Neale has organised the SCRAP fly-tipping advice to be on the website and it will go into the notice boards. Will also feature at the CC2 meeting
