C o n s i d e r a t i o n s	<p>Discussion took place on the following Allotment rent.</p> <p>Review of the allotment agreement, nothing needs to change.</p> <p>Tenants to have a rolling agreement for the next 5 years and due to a few problems, with this year's agreements being signed, for Cllr Clare Atkinson to sign the agreements on behalf of the council.</p> <p>Water supply to the field via a bore hole using hand pumps.</p> <p>Empty plots (3) after being left by tenant get very overgrown, suggested to use allotment rent money to get 3 quotes from business to come and cut down and dig the overgrown plots.</p> <p>Our maintenance man using the site for dumping his rubbish until he can get to the tip. Suggested that we make him a pallet compost area, in exchange for a few odd jobs doing on site free of charge.</p> <p>Having bees on site by a professional bee keeper.</p>
