Crime Speeding Traffic and Roads Safety Advisory Group

- 1) Community speed watch updated and additional roads to be covered with Inn Lane, Quarry Bank and outside primary school. John Cosham is HPC coordinator of volunteers with Steve Bullock Community Speed Watch Coordinator for the police. Expected that training will begin in April. We may need to hire a suitable venue with access to a screen and projector, we request permission of the council to hire the committee room if it can be arranged. Meanwhile we are still awaiting vetting to be done.
- 2) Double yellow lines request outside school bottom of Inn lane by primary school was discussed it was felt that this would probably be unenforceable. Advice will be sort from West Mercia police over enforcement issues
- 3) We have battery issues on the VAS signs on Old Worcester Rd now that the lengthsman has resigned so we will approach Tony Miller to see if we can use some of his monies to upgrade these VAS signs to solar powered.
- 4) We have no specific priorities for the Police Community Charter and would ask the Clerk to inform Catherine Atkinson of this decision
- 5) There is no firm update yet on the installation of the CCTV but we are expecting progress in April
