

## November Report for CST & RS Working party

No meetings were held this month

We have included in our budget request monies to site 2 x 75mm steel posts on Inn Lane and Quarry Bank, whilst waiting for next year's budget we could ask Cllr Miller if he could get the Highways to undertake a feasibility study on both though roads

There is still no progress on vetting of the community speed watch group, apologies from Ben Mawby PCSO but they are inundated with vetting requests and as it is a voluntary scheme it's not high on their work list.

The speed camera van has been present in the Parish on a number of occasions. Also patrols by marked cars have increased this maybe due to increased liaison with police.

Following recent vandalism and metal thefts at The Birches CCTV cameras have been installed around the building these are remotely monitored by an external security firm. Smoke alarms have also been fitted.

Due to an issue with the scheduled installation we are waiting for a rescheduled date for the CCTV to be installed, around the Parish Hall.
