

Policy for use of Facebook

1. The aim of the Hartlebury Parish Council Facebook page is to:
Provide information and updates regarding activities and opportunities within Hartlebury Parish and promote positive thoughts and comments from residents.
2. To ensure that all discussions on the Hartlebury Parish Council page are productive, respectful and consistent with the Council's policies, we ask you to follow these guidelines:
 - Be considerate and respectful of others. Vulgarity, threats or abusive language will not be tolerated.
 - Differing opinions and diverse ideas are encouraged, but personal attacks on anyone, including Hartlebury Parish Council members or staff, will not be permitted.
 - Share freely and be generous, but be aware of copyright laws; be accurate and give credit where credit is due.
 - Stay on topic.
 - Do not use the Facebook page for commercial purposes or to market products.
3. The Facebook page is not monitored 24/7 and we will not always be able to reply individually to all messages or comments received. However, we will endeavour to ensure that any emerging themes or helpful suggestions are passed to the relevant people.

Sending a message/post via Facebook will not be considered as contacting the Council for official purposes and we will not be obliged to monitor or respond to requests for information through the Facebook channel.
